

Timetables

The Hampshire County Council's published timetables need time to interpret. When booking Cango you will be given an approximate time for your pick-up, based on the timetable for the timed stops. Remember that times may vary according to the number and location of pick-ups. Given below are the principle leaving times of Cango services from the starting points of each journey.

C32 Services - Monday, Wednesday and Friday

Lymington to Sway and New Milton
09.35 - 12.35 and 16.05
(Sway times are 09.55 - 13.10 and 16.30)

Lymington to Sway only 14.55

Lymington to Lower Buckland only 11.40

Sway to Lymington 08.47 and 15.26

New Milton (Tesco) to Sway and Lymington
10.30 and 13.45

New Milton (Tesco) to Sway only 17.05
(must be booked)

C33 Services - Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday

Lymington to Sway and New Milton
09.35 - 11.45 and 16.10
(Sway times are 09.55 - 12.20 and 16.35)

Lymington to Sway only 14.55

Sway to Lymington 08.47 and 15.26

New Milton (Tesco) to Sway and Lymington
10.30 and 13.45

New Milton (Tesco) to Sway only 17.10
(must be booked)

Note: The leaving times at New Milton (Bradbeers) are two minutes after New Milton (Tesco) times.

Hampshire Fare Pass

Residents of Hampshire who are over retirement age, disabled or who are not permitted to drive for medical reasons, may be eligible for a Hampshire Fare Pass.

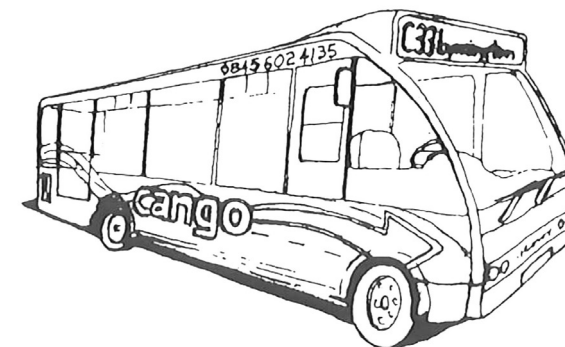

THE CANGO BUS

C32 and C33 Services

Lymington - Buckland - Lymington Hospital
- South Sway - Sway - Tiptoe/Wootton -

This leaflet explains how you can use the distinctive yellow bus.

What is Cango?

Cango is a public bus service which offers transport in a unique and friendly way for everyone from Monday to Saturday. It does not operate on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Cango is for the community and visitors. It caters for young and old, children, students, workers and retired people. Those with mobility, hearing, sight or other disabilities are also able to use the services.

Wheelchairs, rolators, pushchairs, shopping trolleys and certain types of electric buggies are all catered for.

It is for everyone!

The drivers are caring and wait for passengers to be seated before moving off.

The service can respond to your individual needs because the route is not fixed and operates over two roam zones.

The Roam Zones

One zone covers most roads in Lower Buckland and Lymington Hospital area. The second covers most roads and lanes in South Sway, Durnstown, Sway, Tiptoe, Wootton (as far as Bashley Common Road), Bashley and the Gainsborough and Hollands Wood area of New Milton.

Service C32 operates on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and offers passengers approximately one hour in Lymington in the late morning.

Service C33 operates on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays and allows about one hour in New Milton at lunchtime.

Longer periods can be spent if needed.

How to use Cango

If you travel between timed stops you can use Cango without booking your journey. All other journeys must be booked.

Timed Stops - Green signs.

Lymington Post Office, Sway Railway Station.
New Milton - Bradbeers (Department Store) and
New Milton - Tesco (Bus stand near car park).
Cango will definitely stop at these locations on each journey.

Bookable Stops - Yellow signs.

Located in the roam zones at Lymington (Waitrose), Lower Buckland, Lymington Hospital, Pitmore Lane (Wheel Inn), Pitmore Lane (Chapel Lane), Sway Village Hall, Tiptoe, Bashley, Gainsborough and New Milton Station.

You can also arrange a mutually agreeable pick-up-point in the roam zones. If you are a passenger with special needs, you may be able to have Cango come right to your door.

Registration and Booking

Registration is free and you can book your journeys at the same time. Once registered booking can be done daily or up to one month in advance or you can make a regular booking.

Simply telephone **01983 716956** between 07.00 and 09.00 Monday to Friday. Saturday journeys must be booked on Thursday or Friday before.

The booking for journeys on the 08.47 Sway to Lymington service must be made on the day before or on Friday for the Monday following.

The last bus from New Milton must also be booked as it only goes as far as Sway.



How much does it cost?

Cango is free after 09.00 for passengers with Farepasses (blue stripe), Disabled person's passes (orange stripe) and Disabled person's companion's pass (orange stripe with C+ in top right corner). Otherwise fares (single or return) are in line with fares on other bus services.

Lymington (New Forest) Hospital

Arrangements have been made with the Manager at Lymington Hospital for appointments to be made to suit Cango times. Patients should state this when booking their appointments.

Afternoon visiting for relatives and friends

The timetable has been designed to give anyone along the route from New Milton the opportunity to spend almost the whole period of afternoon visiting with patients and then return home.

Appointments with Health Professionals

Appointments can usually be made with Doctors, Dentists, Nurses and other health professionals to fit in with the Cango timetables.
